50/50 Cornhole Tournament: After the shooting events both days, we will be holding a cornhole tournament. The cost to enter the tournament is \$20.00 per player with the winner splitting the pot with Bailey McMMain's cancer treatment fund.

Safety and Shooting Rules

1. Each shooter must complete a registration form and waiver and email it to Lisa.Ruiz@forddavisowcamp.com prior to the event.
2. Please arrive at the shooting facility in one (1) vehicle per team, where possible.
3. **No** alcohol consumption before or during the event, whether competing or not.
4. All shooters must be experienced with a shotgun.
5. For the safety of the event, we ask that no guests attend unless they are a parent or guardian of a minor and both registered for the event, limited to one guest per minor.
6. Eye and hearing protection must be worn at all times during live competition, whether shooting or in the staging area at the pavilion.
7. **No** riot shotguns, defense shotguns (guns with pistol type grip), coach guns, or shotguns with barrels less than 26".
8. **No** steel shot.
9. Only **two** (2) shells at a time are allowed to be loaded in your shotgun.
10. Only load the shotgun when it is your turn to shoot.
11. Make sure your shotgun is unloaded before you move to another station or exit the shooting area.
12. When you are in a shooting station, always keep the muzzle of the shotgun pointing down range.
13. Unless you're shooting, break the barrels on O/U & SXS shotguns and point the barrel towards the ground; on S/A and Pump shotguns, keep the receivers in the open position with barrel facing upwards.
14. Target loads only as follows:
 - a. 12 & 16 gauge
 - i. shot weight (1 or 1 ½ oz)
 - ii. shot size (9, 8, or 7 ½)
 - iii. shell length (2 ¾")
 - b. 20 gauge
 - i. shot weight (⅞ oz)
 - ii. shot size (9, 8, or 7 ½)
 - iii. shell length (2 ¾")
 - c. 28 gauge
 - iv. shot weight (¾ oz)
 - v. shot size (9, 8, or 7 ½)
 - vi. shell length (2 ¾")
 - d. 410 gauge
 - vii. shot weight (½ oz)
 - viii. shot size (9, 8, or 7 ½)
 - ix. shell length (2 ½")

(8 ½ shot is allowable in all gauges.)

15. There will be a menu posted at each station that designates what traps you will shoot. The first target thrown will be a single that you are allowed to shoot twice at. The second target is a report pair. The shooter calls pull for the first target and when the gun fires the trapper automatically pulls the second target. The third target is a true pair (both targets are thrown simultaneously). It's up to the shooter to determine what target to shoot first. Before the competition begins, the shooters will be allowed to view all the targets on the menu. The shooter in station one will ask the trapper to pull each target twice. When all the targets are viewed, competition can begin.
16. In the case of a rainout, this event may not be rescheduled. All proceeds will be donated as specified.
17. Tiebreakers, if necessary, will be determined by a knockout round of shooting per group, per day. The overall winner may be determined by a shoot-off on Sunday, November 12, after the final shoot from Group IV is complete.
